

SPECIAL NOTICES

1. **VACCINATIONS** – All exhibits must be inoculated against Feline Infectious Enteritis, FHV & FCV (cat flu) the full course in accordance with manufactures recommendations must have been completed **at least 15 days** prior to the show You will be required to produce a current vaccination certificate for each exhibit.
2. **NAMES OF EXHIBITS** – The full registered name (exactly as stated on the registration document, including any registration letter and/or titles or awards) must be stated on the show entry form.
3. **SHOW CLASSES** – The Show Manager will enter your exhibit in the appropriate class according to the information entered on the entry form. **IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY** of the exhibitor to ensure that the details in the catalogue are correct and if a mistake is found, the exhibitor must inform the Secretariat before the commencement of judging.

Awards and titles gained at the show are dependent on the correct information concerning your cat being available to the Show manager. Please take the time to make sure that you have 'got it right'. Once the show is over it is too late to do anything about it.

White Cats:

It is a FIFe rule that no white cat can be accepted without having a Certificate of Hearing. This certificate should be shown to the Veterinarian when passing through the vetting in procedure.

Rosettes:

At this show the club will not be giving out rosettes automatically. Rosettes will be available to purchase on production of your report form detailing the award your cat has won.

All BIV, Nomination and BIS Rosettes will be presented as usual. It is only the class rosettes that you may purchase if you wish.
